



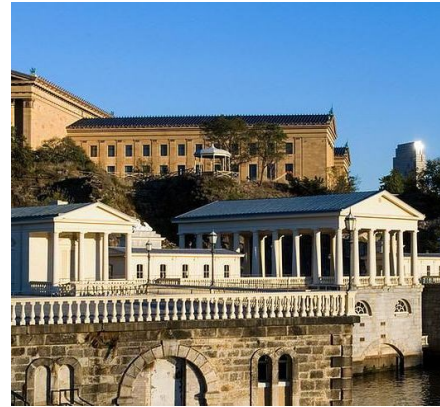
## *The Week Ahead*

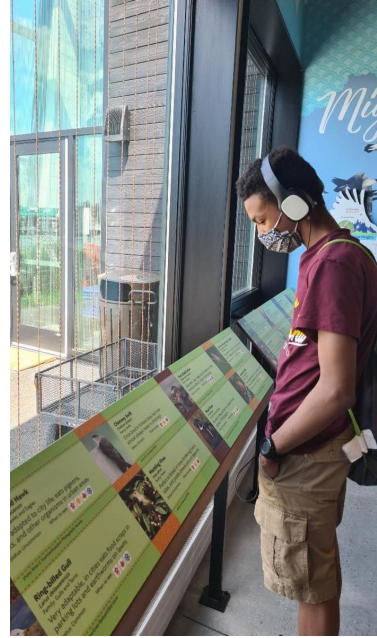
