



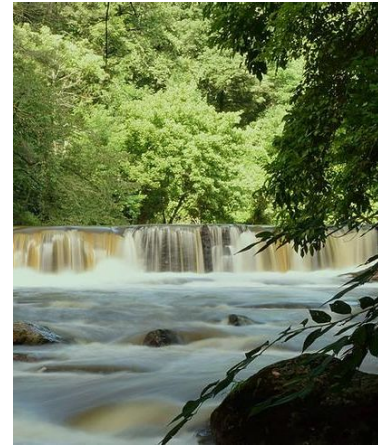
The Week Ahead
